On 29 March 2024, the Lago Mar Civic League held its annual Town Hall Meeting with the community at the Lago Mar Park at Back Bay from 1030 to 1130 AM. In attendance from the Civic League were:

The meeting was open to all residents with 15 attending along with an individual running for the VA Beach School Board that wanted to address the group. (Vincent Smith).

The President opened the meeting providing an overview of how the annual membership dues (\$115) are allocated and reiterated that funds derived from membership do not go to the purchase of Alcohol which is purchased through donations solicited by Stroll Magazine.

The Treasurer reviewed the 2024 Budget and echoed that the Civic League members are Stewards of the annual membership funds and the decisions on distribution of funds is decided by the Lago Mar Civic League board.

There was a proposal by a member of Knights of Columbus from St Mary's Catholic Church to do the landscaping (ie mulch) for a reduced fee (which will be reviewed by the Board) and the importance of a contract to do the work.

The Membership Committee discussed membership and visiting new neighbors as they move into the neighborhood. Along with a donated Welcome Basket the Civic League, the annual fee, and being a member will be reviewed regardless of owning or renting.

Following discussions included the windfarm off the North Carolina coast and cables running through Sandbridge and up the eventual Nimmo extension. The Board agreed that any information passed on by concerned citizens will be placed on Civic league social media outlets.

The meeting was adjourned at 1130.
